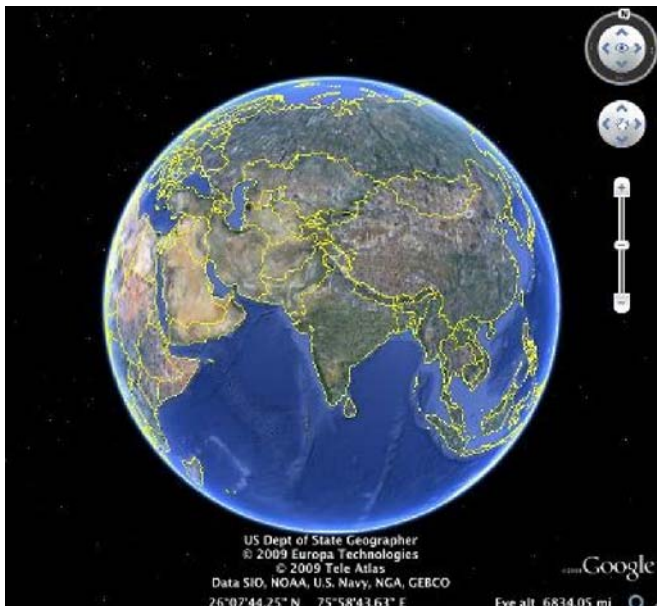


# Google Earth Across the Curriculum
